In maths this term, we are continuing to consolidate our learning of one more and one less as well as composing numbers from 0 to 5. To progress learning we will be moving onto numbers to 8 and will look at finding doubles alongside odd and even numbers. We will also be looking at mass and comparing capacity.

To support your child at home, please continue to support children with recognising and forming numerals to 10. Encourage children to explore one more or one less when finding numbers within everyday objects and tasks.

Continue to read to your child and discuss books every day. Record this in their reading record.

Two books will be sent home on **Friday** each week and should be returned on the following **Thursday**.

Continue to help your child to blend known sounds and to start blending sounds in their head so they can begin to string multiple words together to read simple sentences.
