Choose an activity to complete as a family each week. You can add any photographs you take or scan any learning and then upload them to Google Classroom. We would love to see it.

| Upload a photo showing how you<br>care for God's creation, eg.<br>looking after animals, watering<br>plants, litter picking, etc  | Minibeast Safari - look closely<br>in your garden or when out on a<br>walk. Can you spot any<br>minibeasts? How are they the<br>same as each other? How are<br>they different?   | Draw/paint a minibeast or use<br>playdough to make a minibeast.  |
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| . Share a story about an<br>animal/minibeast. Can you retell<br>this story in your own words?<br>What happened at the<br>beginning, in the middle and at<br>the end? What was your<br>favourite part of this story?   | Create a made up animal. Could<br>you mix the features of<br>different animals together?<br>e.g. the whiskers of a cat and<br>the curly tail of a pig. It could<br>be a drawing, a collage, a<br>sculpture or created using junk<br>modelling!   | Research an animal of your<br>choice and write some<br>interesting facts about it.<br>What does it eat? Where does<br>it live? What does it look like?   |
| Show that you can order the<br>months of the year. What will<br>the weather be like in each of<br>the months? Which months will<br>be in which season?  | Draw an animal and label its<br>features e.g. legs, body, wings<br>etc.  | Learn the song, 'The Animals<br>Went in Two by Two' and draw<br>out two of each animal and<br>practice counting them.  |
| Make a musical carnival of<br>different animal sounds e.g. an<br>elephant, lion, fish. What<br>household items could you find<br>to make each animal sound?<br>Think about what sounds they<br>make when you bang them, tap<br>them, shake them, rub them<br>etc. What makes a bee like<br>sound in your house? Or a sound<br>like a trumpeting elephant? Or<br>a roar like a lion? | Get an empty box e.g., cereal<br>box/shoebox etc. Use this to<br>make a habitat for an animal.<br>Think about what the animal<br>will need in its habitat. Can you<br>use items from the house to<br>create it e.g. cotton wool for<br>snow, eggs boxes as hills,<br>twigs/leaves for trees etc. | Choose a country that you know<br>someone from and find out<br>what animals live there. You<br>could ask as many people as you<br>could about animals around the<br>world and see how many<br>different animals you find out<br>about! |
