



Spring 1 Homework

Choose an activity to complete as a family each week. You can add any photographs you take or scan any learning and then upload them to Google Classroom. We would love to see it.

Upload a photo showing how you care for God's creation, eg. looking after animals, watering plants, litter picking, etc	Minibeast Safari - look closely in your garden or when out on a walk. Can you spot any minibeasts? How are they the same as each other? How are they different?	Draw/paint a minibeast or use playdough to make a minibeast.
. Share a story about an animal/minibeast. Can you retell this story in your own words? What happened at the beginning, in the middle and at the end? What was your favourite part of this story?	Create a made up animal. Could you mix the features of different animals together? e.g. the whiskers of a cat and the curly tail of a pig. It could be a drawing, a collage, a sculpture or created using junk modelling!	Research an animal of your choice and write some interesting facts about it. What does it eat? Where does it live? What does it look like?
Show that you can order the months of the year. What will the weather be like in each of the months? Which months will be in which season?	Draw an animal and label its features e.g. legs, body, wings etc.	Learn the song, 'The Animals Went in Two by Two' and draw out two of each animal and practice counting them.
Make a musical carnival of different animal sounds e.g. an elephant, lion, fish. What household items could you find to make each animal sound? Think about what sounds they make when you bang them, tap them, shake them, rub them etc. What makes a bee like sound in your house? Or a sound like a trumpeting elephant? Or a roar like a lion?	Get an empty box e.g., cereal box/shoebox etc. Use this to make a habitat for an animal. Think about what the animal will need in its habitat. Can you use items from the house to create it e.g. cotton wool for snow, eggs boxes as hills, twigs/leaves for trees etc.	Choose a country that you know someone from and find out what animals live there. You could ask as many people as you could about animals around the world and see how many different animals you find out about!
