

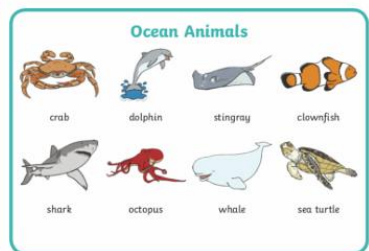
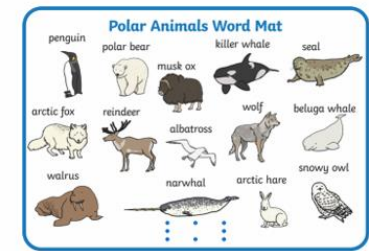
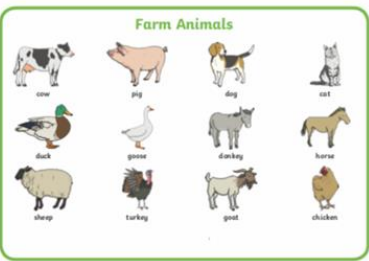
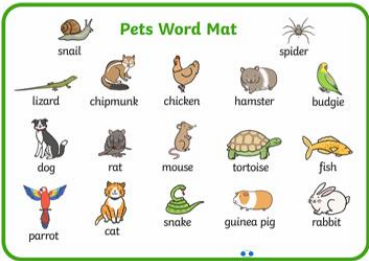
EYFS Knowledge Organiser – All Creatures Great and Small

| Key Vocabulary | |
|-------------------|--|
| Habitat | The natural home or environment of an animal or plant |
| Endangered | A plant or animal that is in danger of disappearing forever. |
| Herbivore | An animal that only eats plant based foods |
| Carnivore | An animal that mostly eats other animals. |
| Omnivore | An organism that regularly eats a variety of material, including plants, animals, algae, and fungi |
| Nocturnal | A living thing that sleeps during the day but becomes active during the night |
| Predator | An animals that lives by killing and eating other animals. |
| Prey | An animal that is hunted or killed by another animal for food. |
| Species | A particular type of animal or plant |

During this topic, the children will be learning about a variety of real-life creatures as well as any that come to their imagination. We will be exploring this using our indoor and outdoor environment.

- Children will explore safari/underwater/minibeast animals through small world play.
- Children will look at and explore their own environment and environments where animals may live, talking about similarities and differences.
- We will be investigating floating and sinking.
- Children will investigate how mini beasts live & move through observation and by using information in non-fiction books.
- The children will explore how a farm/zoo works.
- The children will explore how animals are cared for on a farm/zoo and kept safe.
